Stephanie T. Bolden

Stephanie T. Bolden is a distinguished pioneer in Delaware's political arena. She is the longest serving, elected Black woman in the state of Delaware, including the second Black woman elected to Wilmington's City Council serving 5 terms and the first woman elected President Pro Tempore.

Bolden was elected to represent District 2 in the Delaware State Assembly in 2010. She was also an educator in both public schools and higher education for more than 30 years. Bolden established the Burton-Phelan Memorial Scholarship Program to provide financial assistance to matriculating college sophomores, juniors, and seniors who maintain a 2.5 GPA and must live in the Second Rep. District. Bolden also established the Girl Scout Troop #143 for homeless and low-income girls on the Eastside of Wilmington. She served as Girl Scout Troop Leader for 12 years.
